

Kimberly Maass Ott Statement

July 29, 2008

RE: Incident Report #990137740 Part 8 dated 11-99

Rationale: It has been brought to my attention due to recent events on the news that my name was falsely included on a police report by the Appleton Police Department.

It is my intent to set the record straight so that the investigations surrounding Youth Educated in Safety may proceed with factual and documented information available to the public.

My name was noted as the complainant on a report issued in November of 1999. The police officer of record was Julie Russell. I have neither visited the police department in Appleton, nor have I ever filed a police report in any fashion.

The only contact I had with Officer Julie Russell was in a follow up phone call she placed to me after Dawn Alft and Carol Jacques issued a complaint and evidence files at that time. The questions that Officer Russell asked me were the following;

1. Did you have any suspicions of Jay Breyer and possible theft in regard to Youth Educated in Safety's finances?
2. Did you have any paperwork to prove any possible allegations?
3. I remember the conversation as being short and not lasting more than 2 minutes by the telephone.

My responses were –

1. No I did not handle the finances. I didn't handle the accounting and had no awareness of the incident being reported.
2. At the time of the complaint by Dawn Alft and Carol Jacques I was not affiliated with the organization, Mr. Breyer erroneously told me that the Board had asked for my resignation. Later I found out through Board Member Corinne Boch, that it was not my resignation they had asked for, it was Jay Breyers' resignation they had asked for. I found the lies told by Mr. Breyer saddening in that I had been a Cofounder of the organization and I had many years of dedicated service to the mission of Missing Persons.

The lies about my termination from the organization and the further deceptions in regard to my income taxes were disappointing and dissolutioning. Further the discovery of a false police report stating that I had been a complainant in a report to the police needs to be set straight.
