

Misrepresentations on the 2006 *990 Tax Returns

Please note the 2006 filing of the former Youth Educated in Safety has many errors and misstatements. Given the fact that the 2008 board found through an independent audit deceptions in services to the public, we believed it important to call your attention to the falsified IRS document attached.

Errors are as follows to the best of our knowledge;

1. Terri McCormick was not a Board Member of this organization in 2006 or 2007; the use of her name is false and misleading. We also found Terri McCormick's name used on several fundraising documents in 2007 without permission or knowledge of the board.
2. The organization's President at the time of this filing 2006, 2007 to Early 2008 was Attorney Tim Hawley of Appleton , WI . It was not Jay Breyer (aka Beyer).
3. The organization's Secretary was Patty Ulrich during 2006, the 990 for the organization erroneously reports Jay Breyer 's wife, Molly Breyer as the Secretary.
4. The organization's Treasurer was never disclosed to the board of directors at that time nor were any financials. The 2006 *990 reports indicate a treasurer unknown to the board of directors, who is believed to be Cindy Jenneman sister of Jay Breyer .
5. A majority of the board members listed on the 2006 *990 tax returns have now appeared on the Board of "Mission Home," State of Wisconsin 2009, as organized by Barbara Marksman.

2008 Board Decisions

Late March 2008 Received Access to Records and Docs

October 1, 2008 dissolved the Organization due to a series of erroneous and false representations made to the board of directors in regard to finances, services and the condition of the organization.

May 2009 filed the 2008 *990 Tax Returns on time as scheduled
