Good morning Terri,

In response to your request, Susan WhiteHorse, the manager of the Wisconsin Clearinghouse, has compiled the following list of contacts with Mr. Breyer and the Y.E.S organization. The following is the text of Ms. WhiteHorse's email to me:

Ms. McCormick: In your email of May 30, 2008, you posed specific questions for the Wisconsin Clearinghouse re: Y.E.S. 1996-2008.

My supervisor, Division of Criminal Investigation/Investigative Services Bureau Director Craig Klyve, has asked that I provide you with the following information:

- The Wisconsin Clearinghouse has never worked with Y.E.S. in an investigative capacity. Although Jay Breyer did occasionally contact the Clearinghouse with information about a missing person, the Clearinghouse was already aware of the information because the case had been referred to the Clearinghouse either by the National Center or by law enforcement.
- The Wisconsin Clearinghouse has requested assistance from Y.E.S. in two capacities: 1) We have contacted Jay Breyer and asked him to assist victim families with printing posters. 2) We have provided contact information regarding Y.E.S. to victim families. These families could then determine whether they wished to contact Y.E.S. to utilize available resources and services.
- The Wisconsin Clearinghouse can produce a list of victim families referred to Y.E.S. to have posters produced. We do not track casual referrals to Y.E.S. or other non-profit organizations.
- Neither Jay Breyer nor any other Y.E.S. staff member has attended training provided by the Department of Justice. The Fox Valley Technical College, the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Program and the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children provide specialized training for both clearinghouses and non-profit missing children organizations in providing support to victim families. The WI Clearinghouse has provided some sessions upon request from FVTC. I am aware that Jay Breyer has attended such training sessions.
- In addition to Jay Breyer, I have met two other Y.E.S. staff members: Patty Ulrich, Board of Directors, and Chris Jossart, Executive Director.
- The Wisconsin Clearinghouse has participated in training conferences hosted by Y.E.S. called "Families of Missing Children in Crisis". At those training events, the role of the Clearinghouse was to provide a presentation regarding Wisconsin's Amber Alert System and the Clearinghouse's resources and services.

Please advise if you require further information from the Wisconsin Clearinghouse.
